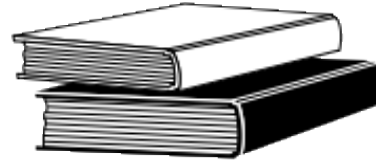
# All About Friends

The current edition of the Enterprise Friends of the Library was established in the spring of 1995. Interested volunteers revamped the by-laws, filled the board positions and went to work.

## Purpose

- To maintain an association of people interested in books and libraries.
- To focus public attention on library services, facilities, and needs.
- To generate funds for library support and improvement.
- To stimulate gifts of books, magazines, desirable collections, endowments, and bequests for the Enterprise Public Library.

For the past 14 years a small corps of volunteers have done just that. Our primary fund raising events are book sales. Coupled with membership, the Friends have raised over \$60,000 which has been used by the library for everything from buying library materials to providing up-to-date training for staff members.

### Three free interlibrary loans a year

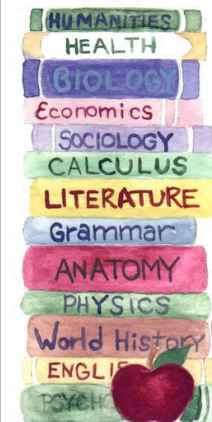
Your "Oops" membership card gives you three free interlibrary loans. It pays for the cost of "borrowing" books from other libraries.
